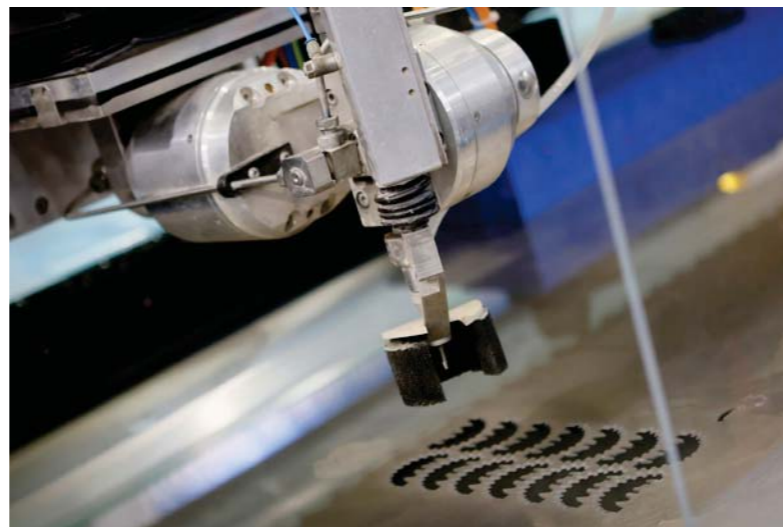
This year's MSV International Engineering Fair met all our expectations. Our stand presented innovations and new products in the field of welding technology.
